Viking Longboat Instructions

- You will need:
- Red paint
 - Cardboard
 - Masking tape + Scissors
 - Red Card
 - Black Jello + pencil
 - Wooden sticks + Popsicle
 - String
 - Glue

1. Cut the dragon's head shapes out of cardboard and draw a dragon head separately, cut that out too

also, cut a base out of cardboard

2. Cut a slot in the bottom of the dragon head and glue it into the base


Remember: take out the glue from the base!

3. Paint a red eye on the dragon head

4. Add the base through the bottom of the dragon head and glue it in. Make sure the dragon head is on top of the base. Use the masking tape to secure it on the sides but with a gap at the bottom.
