Science – exploring different flowers and invertebrates found in our local area. Explore ways of grouping and classifying flowers and animals in our local and wider environment. English – writing information fact files about invertebrates. Reading non-fiction texts in order to retrieve and record information. Writing riddles about chosen creature.
