Year 4

What happens to the food we eat?

Science – investigating how to look after our teeth and what damages them, comparing the teeth of herbivores and carnivores and suggesting reasons for differences, identifying the main parts of the human digestive system and their function. Construct and explain a simple food chain.

English – writing a story about being shrunk and swallowed by mistake.
Information text – leaflet about how to look after our teeth.

Art –drawings of fruit, reflecting design. Use drawing to make a polystyrene tile to create a reflected press print design.

Computing – digital literacy - word processing skills. Creating a digital text using Book Creator.
