EXPRESSIVE ARTS & DESIGN

Songs for Christmas. Dance lessons. Making Christmas decorations. Celebration workshop.. Role play – Santa's grotto, dressing up etc. Use of imagination in listening to stories.

Exploring & using media and materials 40-60 constructs with purpose, using a variety of resources. Selects appropriate resources & adapts work where necessary. ELG – safely use and explore a variety of materials, tools & techniques, experimenting with colour, design, texture, form & function. Being imaginative 40-60 chooses particular colour for purpose, Introduces storyline or narrative into play, plays co-operatively as part of a group to develop & act out narrative. ELG represent own ideas, thoughts & feelings through DT, art, music, dance, role pay & stories.

UNDERSTANDING THE WORLD

Bonfire night, birthdays, Diwali, Hanukkah. The Christmas Story. Baking activities to look at change. Winter. Age appropriate computer programmes,

People & communities ELG – know about similarities & differences between themselves and others, and amongst families & communities. The world – 40-60 look closely at similarities, differences, patterns & change. ELG talk about features of own immediate environment and how environments may vary. Technology – ELG recognise a range of technology is used in places such as home & school. Select & use technology for particular purpose

PHYSICAL DEVELOPMENT

Games lessons. Dance lessons. Pencil control, letter formation, fine motor control. Making decorations using a variety of tools & resources. Outdoor climbing & balancing

30-50 Holds pencil correctly & uses with good control. Can copy some letters. 40-60+ experiments with different ways of moving. Uses simple tools to effect changes to material. Begins to form recognisable letters. Forms recognisable letters, most of which are correctly formed. Travels with confidence & skill around, under, over & through balancing & climbing equipment.

PSED

SEAL. Class Christian Value – Friendship. Speaking and listening groups – Mr Men stories and discussions. Class promises. Role play areas. All classroom activities and outdoor activities. Taking part in Christmas performance and party.

Making relationships 30-50 Forms good relationships with peers. Demonstrates friendly behaviour. 40-60 takes steps to resolve conflicts with peers. Self confidence & awareness 30-50 communicates freely about home & community. Shows confidence in asking adults for help. 40-60 Can describe self in positive terms & talks about abilities. Managing feelings & behaviour 40-60 understands that own actions affect other people. Beginning to be able to negotiate & solve problems without aggression.

MATHEMATICS

2D and 3D shapes. Creating & following patterns. Counting and recognising numbers to 20. Language of adding & subtracting. Practical activities to weigh & measure in Santa's grotto.

SSM 40-60 Shows an interest in shapes & space using shapes appropriately for tasks. Order 2 Or 3 items by length or height. Order 2 items by weight or capacity. Numbers 40-60 Select correct numerals 1-10. Uses language 'more' & 'fewer' to compare 2 sets. Finds total number of items in 2 groups by counting all of them. Finds 1 more or 1 less from a groups of up to 10 objects. Begins to use the language of addition & subtraction in practical activities. ELG Numbers to 20. Problem solving.

COMMUNICATION AND LANGUAGE

Letters & Sounds. .Speaking & Listening groups & SEAL. Role play in Santa's grotto & outdoor. Dressing up. Questions to extend thinking in all activities. Hotseating activities. 'Inside my Imagination' stories.

Listening & Attention. 40-60 Maintains attention and concentrates. Two-channelled attention.ELG Listen attentively in a range of situations. Understanding ELG Follow instructions involving several ideas and actions. Speaking 40-60 Uses language to imagine and recreate roles & experiences in play. ELG Express themselves effectively showing awareness of listener's needs.

LITERACY

Letters & Sounds. Reading Area. Pencil control activities. Writing words & simple sentences. Writing letters, lists & cards. Letter formation activities. Guided Reading.

Reading 40-60 Hears & says initial sounds in words. Can segment & blend the sounds in simple words. Begin to read simple words & sentences. ELG Read and understand simple sentences. Read some common irregular words. Writing 40-60 Give meaning to marks made. Uses some clearly identifiable letters to communicate meaning. Write own name and simple words, sentences and captions. ELG Use phonic knowledge to write words in ways which match their spoken sounds.
